

CITY COUNCIL MEETING-MAY, 3, 2021-7:00 P.M.-CITY BUILDING. MEETING CALLED TO ORDER. PRESENT: MAYOR CRAIN AND COUNCILMEMBERS: TANNER, SMITH, SARE, HEGG, SALTS AND CITY ATTORNEY POWELL. THE MINUTES FROM THE APRIL 19TH MEETING WERE APPROVED.

PARK CARETAKER, CHRIS PINKERTON, WAS PRESENT TO TELL THE COUNCIL THAT THE GIRLS' SOFTBALL TOURNAMENT WENT VERY WELL LAST WEEKEND. JENNIFER WRIGHT AND HER HUSBAND TOOK GOOD CARE OF EVERYTHING. HE ALSO SAID THAT DARREN BURKE WILL BE PUTTING SOME PIPES IN AT THE POOL.

SUPT. KARUSHIS REPORTED HE IS BEING QUESTIONED ABOUT RESIDENTS INSTALLING SOLAR POWER PANELS IN THE CITY. HE WILL TALK TO IMPA TO GET ANSWERS TO THEIR QUESTIONS.


SUPT. MYERS REPORTED THAT THEY ARE READY TO CLEAN THE WATER TOWER. THERE NEEDS TO BE SOME NEW PRESSURE RELEASE VALVES OR BORROW SOME IF POSSIBLE. THERE ALSO NEEDS TO BE REPAIR DONE ON THE LIFT STATION PUMP DURING THE DRY WEATHER.

POLICE OFFICERS ALEXANDER & FOSTER HAVE BEEN CHECKING ON THE SCHOOL BUS STOP ARMS AND EVERYONE HAS OBEYED THEM SO FAR.

TYLER SCOTT, POOL MANAGER, WAS PRESENT TO BRING COPIES OF THE 2021 POOL PRICES. THEY ARE THE SAME AS IN 2019. HE WOULD LIKE TO INCREASE THE ASST. POOL MANAGER PAY. HE WOULD LIKE TO PAY FAITH BARNES, ASST. POOL MANAGER \$9.00 PER HOUR. TANNER MADE A MOTION TO INCREASE THE PAY AND HEGG SECONDED. THE MOTION CARRIED 5-0. SCOTT WOULD LIKE TO ADD TWO MORE SECURITY CAMERAS AND GET WI-FI AT THE POOL. THE POOL SHOULD OPEN ON MEMORIAL DAY WEEKEND IF EVERYTHING IS READY. THE POOL NEEDS TO BE SANDBLASTED, NEW CONCRETE COATING AND PAINTED. IT WOULD LAST BETWEEN 5-7 YEARS. ALVAREZ INDUSTRIAL CLEANING IS PUTTING TOGETHER A QUOTE.

COUNCILMAN TANNER ASKED IF THE VEHICLES ON 1ST STREET, AND 4TH AND PARK AVENUE ARE GONE. THE POLICE WILL CHECK ON THEM. TANNER SAID HE IS MEETING WITH STEVE POWELL, AT POWELL BUILDING CENTER ABOUT MOVING THE MULCH BAGS THEY HAVE ON THE CITY EASEMENT. TANNER ASKED IF ANY MORE WATER METERS JAVE BEEN INSTALLED AND WAS TOLD THEY HAVE DONE A FEW MORE.


