Mayor Crain will notify Republic service to take a couple roll offs to Neil Smiths and 2<sup>nd</sup> Street to haul off all the junk on his property, we will have Chief Sowers notify Neil Smith that July 13<sup>th</sup> the City will be doing this.


Mayor Crain introduced Ordinance 2021-5 for approval for the yield signs to be replaced with Stop signs.


Board of Works
