
Christian Beaver who is running for State Senator was present to get people to follow him on his Facebook page and to vote May 3, 2022.

Mayor Crain made the motion that Tyler Nolan be moved to a class B MVH employee starting Dec. 27<sup>th</sup>.


Councilmember Tanner 2<sup>nd</sup> Motion carried 3-0.
