Mayor Crain called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. Minutes from the April 4, 2022 Council meeting and Board of Works were approved.

Mayor Crain reported on properties that had letters sent have been checked on. The property at 514 Jefferson Street and property on 4th Street of Kents have had nothing cleaned up. The apartments at 120 3rd Street have cleaned up the property, Josh Thomas has been notified that the property that burnt on 1st street has to be cleaned up by May 15, 2022. Al Harden has also been notified about the old Barber shop that burnt he will have it cleaned up as soon as he is able. Nicole Rahm has been notified about the trailer on Water Street she has until the middle of June to have the trailer removed.

Clerk-Treasurer Knecht will give Attorney Powell copies of previous letters sent to residents for properties and have him send a copy of current ordinance for the next step.

Troy Alexander had a quote for 1 new body camera, the Police department has 1 that has gone bad. Councilmember Tanner made motion to purchase body camera Councilmember Martin 2nd, Motion carried 5-0.

Shannah Costa was present to request a 4 way Stop at 5th and Railroad. She was in an accident a few weeks ago and thinks this needs to be done for the safety of the Children, it is a 2 way Stop now but needs to be a 4 Way since there are so many cars you can't see. She is also concerned about the issue of no crosswalks in that area. Mayor Crain will see what the City can do about this issue.

Clerk-Treasurer Knecht will send a certified letter to Joseph Molica at 1311 8th Street about removing the fence and installing a gate in the back yard, the water meter will not read due to the fence being on top of it, the section of fence needs to be removed by May 2, 2022.

Councilmember Martin was notified from Jake Freeman about donating a kids playhouse that he built to the Park, the Council decided that he might want to donate it to a Church.




