Officer Alexander said once the stop signs at 5th and Railroad are installed the City has to paint the yellow lines to get people to stop parking so close to the stop signs, he stated we need several places looked at in town for parking on one side of the street only.


Bart Crowder reported for the fire department that they had a successful fund raiser at the City Park over the 4th of July Celebration and Thanked everyone who helped.


