CHAPTER 130: GENERAL OFFENSES

§ 130.01 SALE OR TRANSFER OF WEAPONS PROHIBITED.

(A) Sale or transfer of knives, martial arts equipment, supplies, or weapons, other weapons, paraphernalia, explosive devices, fireworks (legal or illegal), firearms or their use, or the use of any device containing or using black powder, gunpowder, or any of its derivatives, shall be prohibited.

(B) This section may, for public displays, shows, or other events, be waived or restricted in part upon petition to the City Council as to time, location, and duration, all of which shall be subject to the approval of the city Police Department and the city Fire Department.

§ 130.02 SALE OR CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES RESTRICTED.

Sale or consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be prohibited except in designated areas at designated times and under those terms and conditions as the Council or the Park Advisory Board may from time to time determine.

§ 130.03 TOBACCO USE ON CITY REAL ESTATE.

(A) It shall be unlawful for any person to use tobacco upon the following City of Covington, Indiana real estate to include: the Covington City Park located north of Park Avenue in the City of Covington, Fountain County, Indiana, except in a designated marked area near the scout cabin within said City Park.

(B) For the purposes of this section, *USE OF TOBACCO*, shall include all uses of tobacco, including cigars, cigarettes, pipes, snuff chewing tobacco or any other substance that contains tobacco. The use of electronic nicotine delivery systems such as e-cigarettes and other nicotine vaping devices are prohibited.

(C) Any violation of this section shall be a Class C infraction with punishment as per Indiana law provided.
