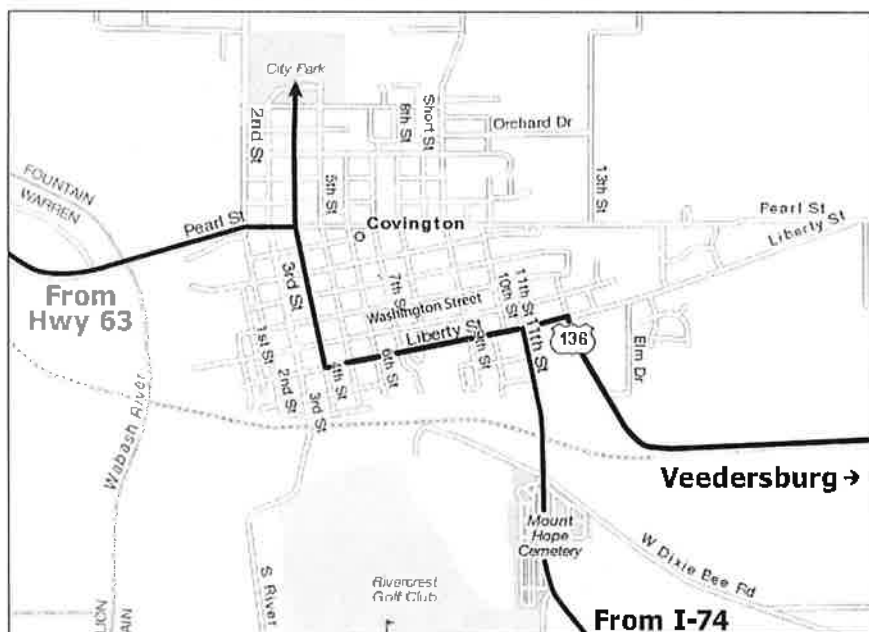

Robert "Bob" Baldwin was born on August 20, 1932, in Niles, Michigan, and moved to Veedersburg, Indiana in 1936. A proud 1950 graduate of Veedersburg High School, Bob went on to serve his country with distinction in the U.S. Naval Air Force. Enlisting in November of 1951, he served four years of active duty and four years in the inactive reserves, through November of 1959, during the Korean War. He was stationed aboard the USS Bon Homme Richard Aircraft Carrier CV31 with CAG7's Fighter Squadron 71, out of Quonset point, Rhode Island. His service took him from Rhode Island to Millington, Tennessee, and then to Kingsville, Texas, where he completed his active duty in 1955.

Upon returning home, Bob joined his father-in-law, Orrin "Pappy" Parish, at the family business—Parish Tire and Battery in Covington. After training in Moline, Illinois, to specialize in alignments and frame straightening, he purchased the business in 1968, when Pappy retired. Bob proudly operated the shop and became a well-known and respected member of the Covington community.

Throughout the years, Bob has generously supported countless local events and programs, including Covington High School sports and music, the Covington 4th of July celebration, the Covington Applefest, and youth leagues for baseball, football, softball, and soccer.

A dedicated public servant, Bob spent more than 20 years with the Covington Volunteer Fire Department—12 of those as Fire Chief. He also served as a precinct committeeman, was a member of the local liquor board, and is a life member of both the American Legion and the VFW, having served as commander for several years.

Bob is a 50+ year Mason and active member of the Scottish Rite, Zorah Shrine, Western Indiana Shrine Club, and Fountain County Low 12. He has helped raise funds for the Shrine for many years by selling thousands of pounds of Vidalia onions.

On May 22, 1953, Bob married Marlene Parish. This year, they will celebrate 72 wonderful years of marriage. Together, they raised three children—Scott (Janeen), Kim (Darrell), and Todd (Becky)—and are proud grandparents to four living grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren.

For his lifelong service, dedication, and unwavering community spirit, we are proud to honor Robert "Bob" Baldwin as the 2025 Covington 4th of July Parade Marshall.

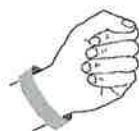

Cash or Check

New Digital Ticketing & Kiosks

- There will be four ticket kiosks to purchase single night wrist bands or digital credits.
- Kiosks will take cash or credit cards. There will be a convenience fee for credit card use.
- Individual ride credits will be put on a plastic card that the ride attendant will scan each time when entering a ride.
- The plastic card can be reloaded with additional credits. There is a small one-time fee per card.
- Cards can be used at Jessop Amusement rides in Covington or any other locations.
- For single night bracelets, the kiosk will issue a QR coded receipt. This receipt must then be taken to the carnival information booth where the single night bracelet is put on the rider. One QR code might be given if purchasing multiple single night bracelets at the same time.

The mega band QR coded cards will also be taken to carnival information booth to receive the six-day wrist band.
